

Deferred Admission Information Sheet

This sheet is intended to help you defer your admission, and obtain the information you will need upon your return. Remember that a deferred admission form is for those who have been admitted to DSU, but have not registered for classes (with the exception of concurrent enrollment).

Step 1: Make sure you have completed the Deferred Admission form. If you have a scholarship, also make sure that you selected the box indicating that you wish to defer your scholarship.

Step 2: Meet with an academic advisor to determine what classes you should take upon returning to DSU. A table is provided below for you to write down the suggested courses. This information can also be found on the Notes section of your **DegreeWorks** account. You will also want to ask your advisor if you will need to take the math section of the CPT test before registering for classes when you return.
